## Summer Enrichment Program

### Courses:

*SEP seeks to motivate local high school students to achieve their goals by providing mentoring and support in a university setting. In **four** weeks during summer time the SEP curriculum offers courses in business, college preparation, communications, and current affairs.*

**Communications:** This course allows students to Learn and practice effective communication in professional, educational, and personal situations that is paramount to success.

**Business:** The course objective is to familiarize students with the business field by utilizing the Junior Achievement student company kit. Students will work in various departments including but not limited to finance, human resources, marketing, and production.
